Course Description:

The focus of this workshop is to develop effective communication and coping strategies for navigating challenging patient encounters in the context of complex pain management. The course will also include exploration of the neurobiological changes that accompany chronic pain and chronic opioid therapy as well as background into cognitive distortions and identification of own personal triggers.

Course Objectives:

- Describe communication tools for responding effectively in conversations with patients about opioids.
- Identify cognitive distortions.
- Describe neurobiological changes that accompany chronic pain and chronic opioid therapy.
- Discover skills and approaches for common and more difficult encounters.
- Identify techniques to establish appropriate boundaries with patients through compassionate detachment and wise mind skills.
