Learn the latest in ostomy care from product selection, skin management, and troubleshooting challenging ostomies. This workshop will include hands-on training for pouching a variety of ostomies, fistulas, and draining wounds. Resources for patient education and discharge planning for the new ostomate will be provided as well as discussion of the RN role in patient adjustment to a new ostomy.
