Tim Cunningham is the Vice President of Practice and Innovation at Emory Healthcare where he also holds an appointment as Adjunct Assistant Professor at the Nell Hodgson School of Nursing at Emory University. Tim graduated from the Clinical Nurse Leader program at the University of Virginia in 2009 and then worked as an emergency/trauma nurse at the UVA Health System, Children's National Medical Center and New York Presbyterian, Cornell. He has worked internationally as a clinician in post-earthquake Haiti; Sierra Leone, during the Ebola outbreak with the organization, Partners in Health; and most recently with Rohingya refugees in Bangladesh. His work as a *Clowns Without Borders* clown and nurse keep bringing him back to the central question: **What keeps people resilient?**
